

**First Amendment to the City of Boise Program Year 2017
Consolidated Housing and Community Development Action Plan**

The City of Boise receives annual funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Cities Program and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Funding is administered by the Division of Housing and Community Development (HCD). The City of Boise has determined it necessary to formally amend the 2017 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Action Plan (October 1, 2017 – September 30, 2018). This Amendment is necessary due to the following substantial changes:

- 1) Sweep and Redirect Funding: \$509,796.48 of unexpended CDBG Entitlement Program Year 2014 (PY14) funds will be used for remodel/improvement of 40-units at 2717 Vista*.
- 2) Sweep and Redirect Funding: \$1427.00 of unexpended CDBG Entitlement Program Year 2015 (PY15) funds will be used for remodel/improvement of 40-units at 2717 Vista.
- 3) Sweep and Redirect Funding: \$128,970.72 of CDBG Entitlement Program Year 2016 (PY16) funds will be used for the remodel/improvement of 40-units at 2717 Vista and 22-units at 1121 S. Capitol**.
- 4) Redirect Revolving Loan Funds (RLF): \$750,000 from the Homeownership RLF to the Home Improvement RLF. The City has had more activities requiring Home Improvement RLF funds than Homeownership.

*2717 S. Vista remodel/improvement will include removing all interior material and replacing with energy efficient appliances & fixtures, new carpet, cabinetry, wall coverings, paint, etc., and temporary relocation for tenants/belongings. Exterior improvements will be made on the second floor hand rail and floor covering. The City will be remodeling/improving all units over the next 2-3 years.

**1121 S. Capitol will include new windows, roof, and exterior paint.

The City of Boise's Housing and Community Development Division will accept public comments on the proposed changes beginning April 18, 2018 through May 20, 2018.
